

If the students, parents and others are not satisfied with the decision of the members of Grievance Redressal Committee, the committee will send the appeals of the students, parents and others to the OMBUDSMAN which was appointed by the concerned University to hear those grievances and ensure its disposal within one month of the receipt for speedy redress of grievances. The committee shall comply with the regulations of the AICTE being made from time to time.


